Impact on development

Job creation

There are currently 26 FTEs working at the customer. The expectation is that direct employment will grow by 20 FTEs of which 10 women. Indirect employment will also increase, but this is more difficult to quantify at the moment.

Increasing the strenght of production

The turnover and profit will increase as a result of this transaction. Turnover will increase by approximately EUR 360,000 on an annual basis to the best estimate. This will also lead to a strengthening of the production power in the chain through additional trade. This is also a transaction that will be continued after positive results.

Sharing of knowledge, skills and techniques

There is technical support from the exporter in the field of cultivation. Employees of the debtor are trained. There is also a discussion with the government of Nigeria, the Wageningen University and Bosman International for a broader capacity building program in Nigeria.

Risk category
