Description

A Dutch company, together with the local subsidiary, will further automate and scale up the existing healhty snack production facility. The investment is in machines, operational costs, means of transport and inventory. The proposed DGGF Starter financing to the Dutch company is in the form of a loan with a term of less than 4 years.

The expected impact is local employment of approximately 32 direct FTE and 45 indirect FTE.

This project will contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals: 2 (Zero hunger), 5 (Gender equality), 8 (Decent Work), 12 (Responsible Production and Consumption) and 13 (Climate action).
